2012 marks the historic 70th anniversary of the signing of Executive Order 9066 on February 19, 1942, by President Roosevelt which forever changed the lives of thousands of Americans of Japanese descent. After decades of silence, this once forgotten American story—one that began with the journey of our *Issei* and *Nisei*—was revived by a small community who demanded redress from its government. In its struggle to regain lost civil rights and its place in history, the story has evolved to mean different things to different people nationally and internationally. Special Tribute to

The Honorable Norman Y. Mineta Recipient of Distinguished Medal of Honor for Lifetime Achievement and Public Service

For almost all of his adult life, Norman Y. Mineta has been in the business of public service. A local San Jose councilman and then mayor, he spent 20 years as a Congressman, where his crowning civil rights achievement was the passage of the Civil Liberties

Act of 1988, providing redress for Japanese Americans. But his service did not end there. He was nominated to be Secretary of Commerce by President Clinton in 2000 and then Secretary of Transportation by President Bush in 2001, becoming the first Asian American to serve at the Cabinet level. His fight against racial profiling in the post 9/11 era is well known.

For that and much more, the Japanese American National Museum presents its highest award, the Distinguished Medal of Honor for Lifetime Achievement and Public Service, to The Honorable Norman Y. Mineta.
